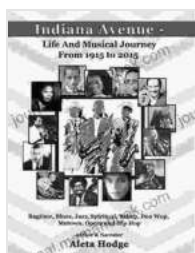

### 1. Ragtime (late 1800s - early 1900s)

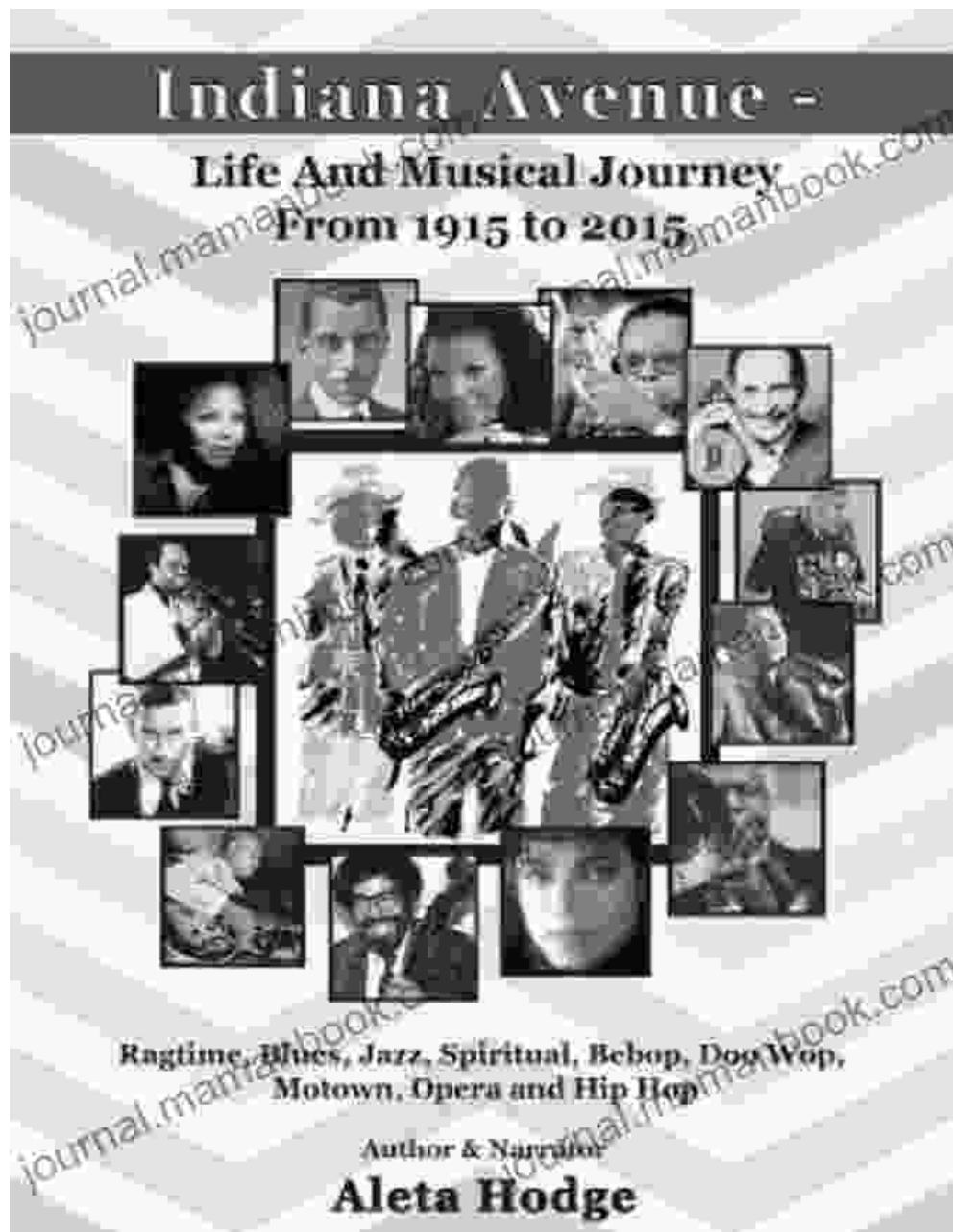

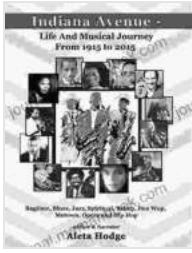

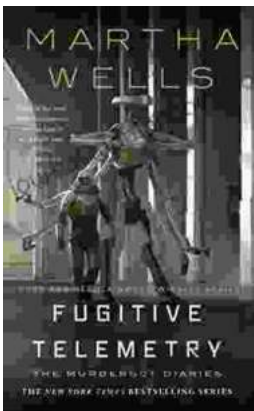
